

LESSON: DERBY ROSE

GRADE LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

OBJECTIVE:

MATERIALS/MEDIA

White 6x9

Permanent marker

Oil pastels

Baby oil

Qtips

LESSON STEPS/PROCESS

1. Briefly review the Derby and the role roses play in the special event. Explain that students are going to draw and create their own roses.
2. Have students go to their seats and pass out paper and permanent markers to have students follow along to draw a rose with Rob (they can start in pencil if they like, just make sure they trace their drawings in permanent marker)
3. Have students return to the floor to demonstrate coloring/blending their flowers. Using the black and white examples, demonstrate coloring the flower using oil pastels (whatever color, does not have to be filled in, are allowed to mix up to two colors together). Then demonstrate how to dip the qtip in baby oil and blend the oil pastels using a circular motion. Make sure to have students switch qtip ends when blending another color (ie: one side for the flower, the other side for the stem)
4. Students can take their creations home with them. Keep baby oil, but toss used qtips.
