

LESSON: EASTER EGG

GRADE LEVEL: PRIMARY

OBJECTIVE: Students will review the art element of line and utilize their knowledge to create an easter egg drawing

### MATERIALS/MEDIA

White 12x18

Chalk

Small water containers

### LESSON STEPS/PROCESS

1. Discuss and list the variety of lines on the board (a line begins and ends with a dot, and how we connect the dots is what creates a line; I usually ask students for different lines to list and end up with a chart pictured below)
2. Demonstrate how students are to use the chalk; they must dip the tip into the water (DO NOT DUNK) to help it glide on the paper. If the tip is already wet there is no need to keep dunking. Water makes chalk melt or disappear super fast.
3. Demonstrate creating an egg and adding lines. To create a giant oval they start with a big 'U' then turn their paper around and make another big 'U' and connect them. They can use whatever lines they like to decorate (the more you demo the better they understand)
4. Pass out paper, chalk baskets, and water (I do one container per two students) once students are seated
5. Clean up in the last 5-7 minutes of class, students can take their drawings home
