

LESSON: UMBRELLA PART 2

GRADE LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

OBJECTIVE: Students will create an artwork using the oil pastel resist process

MATERIALS/MEDIA

Oil pastels (for those needing to finish)

Empty containers

Paint brushes

Blue water color paint

LESSON STEPS/PROCESS

1. Review the primary/secondary colors with students and the steps they have taken from the last class
2. Pass back papers and oil pastels for students to finish coloring; suggest they can use white or blue to draw rain drops/puddle if they like
3. Demonstrate how they will paint their entire paper blue, and the oil pastel should resist the paint from covering their paper. They should carry their paper with TWO hands and place on the drying rack when they finish. They may use ONE wet wipe to clean off their desk and paper.
4. Pass out containers and paint brushes and fill cups 1/3 of the way full of blue paint
5. Clean up with 10 minutes remaining of class

I usually have students sit their water/containers on the side of the sink. You will want to save the paint, so I usually funnel it back into the jug for future use. Rinse containers and wash paintbrushes when you have time.
